Dear Parents,

The Fort Lee School District will be rolling out a 1:1 chromebook initiative for the 2015-2016 school year. The chromebook program will include students in grades 7-12. Each student will receive a Dell chromebook computer to be used in the classroom as well as at home for educational purposes. Teachers will be using computer technology for instruction, assignments, projects, research and assessment.

In order for students to receive a chromebook, a parent or guardian must be in attendance at one of the two sessions scheduled for the appropriate grade level in the FLHS Auditorium. Parents and students will be required to present appropriate identification to receive their chromebook. The schedule is below:
